On January 25, 1965, the Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company filed Supplement No. 3, canceling Supplement No. 2, to WMATC Tariff No. 5; Supplement No. 3, canceling Supplement No. 2, to WMATC Tariff No. 2; and WMATC Tariff No. 17, canceling WMATC Tariff No. 14, to become effective February 26, 1965. The proposed tariffs were accompanied by application pursuant to Regulation 58 et seq., and propose an increase of five (5) cents in certain fares between Washington, D. C., and Interstate Zone 1 in Virginia.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission is of the opinion that the fares, regulations, and practices set forth in said tariffs should be suspended, the use thereof deferred, and the effective date thereof postponed for a period of sixty-five (65) days from the said proposed effective date in order that an investigation may be made and hearing held.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the fares, regulations, and practices set forth in proposed Supplement No. 3 to WMATC Tariff No. 5; Supplement No. 3 to WMATC Tariff No. 2; and WMATC Tariff No. 17 be, and they are hereby, suspended, the use thereof deferred, and the proposed effective date postponed for a period of sixty-five (65) days until May 2, 1965, unless otherwise ordered.

2. That a hearing be held on Friday, March 5, 1965, at 9:30 A.M. in Hearing Room C, Interstate Commerce Commission Building, 12th Street and Constitution Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C.

3. That notice thereof be published by the applicant in a newspaper of general circulation, once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said March 5, 1965.

4. That any testimony of the applicant prepared for presentation under Regulation 23-04 be distributed ten (10) days before the hearing.
