On November 27, 1964, W M A Transit Company filed Application No. 294 for ninety (90) day temporary authority to institute its Route "O", effective December 28, 1964, from the intersection of Dallas Drive and Dallas Place in Prince Georges County, Maryland, to its terminal on 11th Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., in the following manner:

WESTBOUND

Leave bus stand on Dallas Place northeast of Dallas Drive; southwest on Dallas Place; southeast on Dallas Drive; northeast on St. Barnabas Road; northwest on 28th Avenue; west on St. Clair Drive; southwest on Kenton Place; northwest on 23rd Parkway; northeast on Iverson Street; northwest on 25th Avenue; northeast on Colebrooke Drive; northwest on Branch Avenue; northeast on Southern Avenue; northwest on Suitland Road, S. E.; north on 38th Street, S. E.; northwest on Pennsylvania Avenue, S. E.; north on 2nd Street, S. E. and N. E.; west on Constitution Avenue; northwest on Pennsylvania Avenue, N. W.; north on 11th Street, N. W. to bus stand south of E Street, N. W.

EASTBOUND

Leave bus stand south of E Street, N. W., via north on 11th Street, N. W.; east on E Street, N. W.; south on 3rd Street, N. W.; east on Adams Drive; south on 2nd Street, S. W.; east on Independence Avenue; southeast on

Pennsylvania Avenue, S. E.; south on 38th Street, S. E.; southeast on Suitland Road, S. E.; southwest on Southern Avenue; southeast on Branch Avenue; southwest on Colebrooke Drive; southeast on 26th Avenue; southwest on Iverson Street; southeast on 23rd Parkway; northeast on Kenton Place; east on St. Clair Drive; southeast on 28th Avenue; southwest on St. Barnabas Road; northwest on Beaumont Street; southwest on Dallas Place to bus stand northeast of Dallas Drive.

By Orders Nos. 420 and 422 the Commission authorized the temporary authority requested. W M A Transit Company has now submitted an application requesting that this service be authorized on a permanent basis.

The attorney of record in this proceeding is Stanley Kamerow, 1010 Vermont Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C.

The Commission is of the opinion that a hearing on this matter is required.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on Wednesday, March 3, 1965, at 9:30 a.m., at the office of the Commission, 9th Floor, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.
2. That the applicant publish notice of the application and hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Washington Metropolitan District once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said March 3, 1965.
3. That any person desiring to protest this application shall do so in writing, with a copy to the attorney of record, at least ten (10) days prior to said March 3, 1965.
