
By Order No. 36 served July 18, 1961, the Commission suspended Supplement No. 1 to W.M.A.T.C. Tariff No. 1 and deferred the use of the fares stated therein until October 15, 1961, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, in order that the Commission's Accounting Department could audit the books and records of the Company relating to the matters involved in said Supplement No. 1 (which Supplement provides for certain increases in Interline Passenger fares between Washington, D. C., and governmental installations).

Said Order No. 36 also related that the Commission would subsequently set the time and place for a hearing on this matter, and therefore does so in the manner hereinafter set forth.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That this matter shall be heard by the Commission on Wednesday, August 23, 1961, beginning at 10:00 a. m., E.D.S.T., in the offices of the Interstate Commerce Commission, Washington, D. C.
- (2) That the Applicant publish in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District notice of said hearing at least twice, once each successive week, prior to August 23, 1961.
