On February 4, 1965, Airport Transport, Inc., filed WMATC Tariff No. 9, cancelling WMATC Tariff No. 8, and Airport Transport, Inc., of Virginia filed WMATC Tariff No. 1, both to become effective on March 8, 1965. On February 15, 1965, Supplement No. 1 to WMATC Tariff No. 9 was filed by Airport Transport, Inc.

In general, the Tariff of Airport Transport, Inc., proposes an increase in group and family group riding limousine fares from Washington National Airport by fifteen cents (15¢) per passenger, and an increase of One Dollar (\$1.00) for airline crews traveling in charter limousine service. The Supplement No. 1 establishes a rate for service between the Washingtonian Motel, Gaithersburg, Maryland, and the Washington National Airport. WMATC Tariff No. 1 of Airport Transport, Inc., of Virginia proposes a ten cents (10¢) per mile increase for every paid metered mile.

Having reviewed the matters, the Commission is of the opinion that the fares, regulations and practices set forth in said tariffs and supplement should be suspended, the use thereof deferred, and the effective date thereof be postponed for a period of ninety (90) days from the said proposed effective date, in order that an investigation may be made and a hearing held.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the fares, regulations and practices set forth in proposed WMATC Tariff No. 9 and Supplement No. 1 thereto of Airport Transport, Inc., and the proposed WMATC Tariff No. 1 of

Airport Transport, Inc., of Virginia be, and they are hereby suspended, the use thereof deferred, and the proposed effective date postponed, for a period of ninety (90) days until June 6, 1965, unless otherwise ordered.

2. That a hearing be held on Wednesday, April 7, 1965, at 10:00 A. M., in the office of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.

3. That notice thereof be published by the applicant in a newspaper of general circulation at least once, fifteen (15) days prior to said April 7, 1965.

4. That any testimony of the applicant prepared for presentation under Regulation 23-04, be distributed five (5) days before the hearing.
