On May 21, 1965, the Commission directed Holiday Tours, Inc., to furnish certain specified reports to the Commission on or before June 10, 1965. The reports are required by Regulation 67-03 promulgated by General Order No. 10, served March 13, 1964, Regulation 110-06, promulgated by General Order No. 8, served September 20, 1963, and Regulation 57, promulgated by General Order No. 2, served March 22, 1961.

At this time, Holiday Tours, Inc., is conducting charter and special operations pursuant to a "grandfather" application, the disposition of which is presently under judicial review.


The Commission is of the opinion that an order should issue, making Holiday Tours, Inc., respondent hereto, and giving it the opportunity to appear and show cause why the Commission should not issue an order requiring Holiday Tours, Inc., to suspend such operations unless and until said regulations are complied with.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Holiday Tours, Inc., be, and it is hereby, made a respondent to this proceeding.

2. That this matter be set for hearing on Thursday, July 8, 1965, at 9:30 A. M., E.D.T., in the office of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia, for the purpose of giving said respondent an opportunity to appear and show cause why the Commission should not issue an order requiring Holiday Tours, Inc., to suspend operations unless and until Regulations 67-03 and 110-06, are complied with.
