On July 6, 1965, D. C. Transit System, Inc., and W. V. & M. Coach Company filed a joint application for permanent authority to establish the Silver Rocket Express, Route X-4, in the following manner:

Route X-4

From Rockville: Leave terminal stand on the west side of North Washington Street, at the Rockville Plaza Motel, continue south on North Washington Street, southeast on East Montgomery Avenue, north on New Street, southerly on Viers Mill Road, Georgia Avenue, New Hampshire Avenue, Sherman Avenue, Florida Avenue and 9th Street, west on Constitution Avenue, cross Theodore Roosevelt Bridge, west on Arlington Boulevard (U.S. 50), northwest on Leesburg Pike (Virginia Route 7), east on Chain Bridge Road, (Virginia 123), northerly on Interstate Routes 495, 270, and 70S, east on Montrose Road, northwest on East Montgomery Avenue, north on North Washington Street to terminal at Rockville Plaza Motel.

D. C. Transit System, Inc., and W. V. & M. Coach Company were granted ninety (90) day temporary authority effective February 1, 1965, by Order No. 437. A ninety (90) day extension of temporary authority, effective May 3, 1965, was granted the Companies by Order No. 464.

The attorney of record in this matter for D. C. Transit System, Inc., is John R. Sims, Jr., 3600 M Street, N.W., Washington, D. C. The attorney of record for W. V. & M. Coach Company is Manuel J. Davis, 1629 K Street, N. W., Washington, D. C.

The Commission is of the opinion that this matter should be set for public hearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a public hearing on this matter be held on July 22, 1965, at 10:00 A. M., in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia,
2. That the applicant publish notice of the application and time and place of hearing thereon, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least ten (10) days prior to said July 22, 1965.
3. That any person desiring to protest this application shall do so, in writing, to the Commission, with a copy to the attorney of record, at least five (5) days prior to said July 22, 1965.
