Ninety (90) day temporary authority was granted to D. C. Transit System, Inc., by Order No. 485, to establish Routes A-7, B-7, C-7, and D-7. The Route C-7 operation was restricted to prohibit pick-up and discharge (no local service) over that portion of the route that duplicates the route of WMA Transit Company from the intersection of Kenilworth Avenue and Eastern Avenue to Kenilworth Avenue and Calvert Street.

By petition filed June 29, 1965, D. C. Transit System, Inc., requests a ninety (90) day extension of the temporary authority granted by Order No. 485, to be effective August 30, 1965.

WMA Transit Company asserts that the restriction for Route C-7 is not a correct interpretation of an agreement between WMA Transit Company and D. C. Transit System, Inc., whereas D. C. Transit System, Inc., asserts that the restriction, as worded, accurately reflects the agreement.

Informal discussions have failed to resolve this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that a hearing be, and it is hereby, set for Friday, August 20, 1965, at 9:30 A. M., at the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia, for the purpose of taking evidence relative to the restriction for D. C. Transit Route C-7.
