The British Embassy has requested that the bus stops on both sides of the Old British Embassy Building on Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., be abolished. It appears that the majority of their staff has moved to the new building at the corner of Observatory Circle and Massachusetts Avenue, N.W.


It further appears that there are bus stops on both sides of Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., at Observatory Circle, N.W.

It further appears that public convenience and necessity no longer require the bus stops at the Old British Embassy, and that they should be abolished.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That the bus stops on both sides of Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., in front of the Old British Embassy Building be abolished.
- (2) That this Order become effective immediately.
