By Application No. 342, dated September 17, 1965, D. C. Transit System, Inc., requests one hundred eighty (180) day temporary authority to extend its Route Y-8 to serve the newly opened Montgomery Junior College in Rockville, Maryland. This new facility has approximately 1,500 students and is located about one mile from the present Rockville Terminal.

D. C. Transit System, Inc., has received numerous requests for this service from students, parents, faculty, and officials of the school. The extension will make use of layover time at the ends of the route and will not require additional buses or operators.


All trips on Route Y-8 will be extended on weekdays, except the last trip at night. The Company proposes that the service be operated in the following manner:

EXTENDED PORTION: From the Rockville Plaza Motel - continue north over North Washington Street, westerly over roadway to Montgomery Junior College Campus and return.

The Commission is of the opinion that there is an immediate and urgent need for the service described.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is hereby, granted one hundred eighty (180) day temporary authority to extend its Route Y-8 as described above, effective September 28, 1965.
