
On September 2, 1965, by Order No. 523, the Commission set the above matter for further hearing on October 25, 1965. On September 30, 1965, the applicant filed a petition for reconsideration of said order, requesting that the Commission cancel the hearing and issue applicant a certificate. The protestants have filed a reply to said petition, urging denial thereof, on the basis that further hearing is necessary to develop the essential evidence required in order to dispose of inquiries raised by the Court in its Opinion and Order of Remand.

The Commission is of the opinion that further hearing is required to provide all parties an opportunity to present evidence bearing upon and relating to those matters raised in the Court's Opinion. Accordingly, the petition for reconsideration should be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the petition of Holiday Tours, Inc., for reconsideration of Order No. 523 be, and it is hereby, denied.
2. That the location of the hearing scheduled for 10:00 A.M., Monday, October 25, 1965, be, and it is hereby, changed to Hearing Room "C", Interstate Commerce Commission Building, 12th and Constitution Avenue, N.W., Washington, D. C.
