Request has been made for the re-location of a bus stop and a 1-bus zone in Washington, D. C. on the east side of Georgia Avenue from the near side of Rittenhouse Street to the far side between the driveways of the shopping center. It appears that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of this bus stop and 1-bus zone.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a bus stop and 1-bus zone be established at the following location:

On Georgia Avenue N. W.
East side, north of Rittenhouse Street between the driveways of the shopping center

(2) That the following bus stop and 1-bus zone be abolished:

On Georgia Avenue N. W.
East side, south of Rittenhouse Street

(3) That this Order become effective immediately.
