By Application No. 360, dated February 24, 1966, D. C. Transit System, Inc., requested permanent authority to extend its Route Y-8 to serve Montgomery Junior College in Rockville, Maryland.

By Order No. 532, D. C. Transit System, Inc., was granted 180 day temporary authority to extend its Route Y-8, effective September 28, 1965, to the newly opened Montgomery Junior College in the following manner:

EXTENDED PORTION:

From the Rockville Plaza Motel, continue north over North Washington Street, westerly over roadway leading to the Montgomery County Junior College campus and return.

The Commission is of the opinion that this matter should be set for public hearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a public hearing on this matter be held on March 14, 1966, at 10:00 A.M., in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.
2. That the applicant publish notice of the application and time and place of hearing thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least ten (10) days prior to said March 14, 1966.
3. That any person desiring to protest this application shall do so in writing to the Commission, with a copy to the Attorney of Record, at least five (5) days prior to said March 14, 1966.
