By Application No. 363, dated March 15, 1966, D. C. Transit System, Inc., requests authority to change Route Y-2, Silver Spring Community Line, as follows:

Discontinued Portion:

Wayne Avenue - between Pershing Drive and Georgia Avenue
Georgia Avenue - between Wayne Avenue and 16th Street
Extended

Rerouted Portion:

Outbound - From the Silver Spring Transit Center via Pershing Drive, north on Fenwood Street, west on Colesville Road, and north on 16th Street to its intersection with Georgia Avenue.

Inbound - From the intersection of Georgia Avenue and 16th Street, continue southerly on 16th Street, east on Colesville Road, south on Fenton Street, west on Wayne Avenue, thru cut-off to Pershing Drive and continue easterly on Pershing Drive to Terminal west of Fenton Street.



The Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing on this matter is required.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on Monday, April 18, 1966, at 10:00 A. M., in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.
2. That applicant publish notice of its application, and time and place of hearing thereon, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District at least once, twenty (20) days prior to said April 18, 1966.
3. That any person desiring to be heard in this matter shall so indicate to the Commission, in writing, with a copy to the Attorney of Record, at least five (5) days prior to said April 18, 1966.
