Application No. 364

By Application No. 364, dated March 15, 1966, WMA Transit Company requests temporary authority for a period of one hundred eighty (180) days to establish Route T, Belair Express, between Belair, Maryland, and downtown Washington, D. C., as follows:

From the intersection of Belair Drive and Kembridge Drive, over Kembridge Drive to Kenhill Drive, over Kenhill Drive to Belair Drive, over Belair Drive to Starlight Lane, over Starlight Lane to Stonehaven Lane, over Stonehaven Lane to Buckingham Drive, over Buckingham Drive to Belair Drive, over Belair Drive to Maryland Route 3, over Maryland Route 3 to U. S. Route 50 (John Hanson Highway), over U. S. Route 50 to New York Avenue and thence over existing route to 11th and Pennsylvania Avenue, N. W., and return over the same route.

Applicant proposes to operate two A.M. trips to Washington, and two P.M. trips to Belair. Two buses will be required to operate the service, and the fares will be in accordance with tariffs on file with the Commission.

The applicant is the only carrier presently authorized to provide service between Belair, Maryland, and Washington, D. C. However, its existing operating rights do not authorized this particular route.

The Commission is of the opinion that an immediate and urgent need exists for the proposed temporary service, and that one hundred eighty (180) days temporary authority should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That WMA Transit Company be, and it is hereby, granted one hundred eighty (180) days temporary authority to establish Route T, Belair Express, as described herein.

2. That this Order become effective April 4, 1966.
