By Application No. 375, D. C. Transit System, Inc., requested authority to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to include irregular route special operations from Alexandria, Virginia to points in the Metropolitan District. Order No. 609 of the Commission set the matter for public hearing on June 20, 1966.

On May 25, 1966, The Gray Line, Inc., and the Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company, by their counsel, submitted a motion to postpone said hearing until June 22, 1966. The motion indicates that the concurrence of applicant has been secured in the proposed date.

The Commission is of the opinion that the motion should be granted.
