Due to the construction work on North Capitol Street N. W., Washington, D. C., southbound traffic is being re-routed west on O Street and south on New Jersey Avenue. In order to have two lanes cleared for the traffic, it is necessary to remove the streetcar platform, located on New Jersey Avenue between N and O Streets and presently used by the southbound 90 and 91 streetcars.

Since this causes too great a distance between the remaining platforms, another platform should be constructed by the Department of Highway and Traffic, on New Jersey Avenue, north of O Street beginning at the crosswalk.

It appears that public convenience and necessity require the re-location of said platform.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That an asphalt platform be constructed at the following location:

On New Jersey Avenue, N. W.
West side, North of O Street

- (2) That the following concrete platform be removed:

On New Jersey Avenue, N. W.
West side, mid block between N and O Streets

- (3) That this Order become effective immediately.
