The Gray Line, Inc., through its attorney, filed Formal Complaint No. 16 against D. C. Transit System, Inc., alleging that the latter is conducting unauthorized transportation of persons in interstate commerce from points and places in Northern Virginia to points and places in the District of Columbia, and return. Complainant requests that the Commission order D. C. Transit System, Inc., to cease and desist from such operations.

D. C. Transit System, Inc., through its attorneys, has filed an answer maintaining that the transportation in question is performed without charge and, therefore, is outside the jurisdiction of the Commission.

1. That D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is hereby, made a respondent to this proceeding.

2. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Wednesday, September 14, 1966, at 10:00 A. M., in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia 22209.

3. That any interested party desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate in writing to the Commission, with a copy to the Attorneys of Record, at least ten (10) days prior to said hearing.
