On September 15, 1966, Horse Buses Incorporated submitted an application "Requesting Authority To Operate Horse Drawn Hurdic, Sightseeing and Charter Equipment." The Company proposes to provide transportation in horse drawn public conveyances "carrying passengers for hire on an irregular schedule over an unfixed route within a specific area."

The specific area to be served is defined as follows:

GEORGETOWN:

Bounded on the east by Rock Creek and Potomac Parkway from the Potomac River to the north boundary of Dumbarton Oaks Park, on the north by the north boundary of Dumbarton Oaks Park, Whitehaven Street and Whitehaven Parkway to Thirty-fifth Street, south along the middle of Thirty-fifth Street to Reservoir Road, west along Reservoir Road to Archbold Parkway, on the west by the Archbold Parkway from Reservoir Road to the Potomac River, on the south by the Potomac River to the Rock Creek Parkway.

The Company further requests authority to provide:

"Horse Bus Sightseeing Movements applying from points in Georgetown, D. C., to other points in Georgetown, D. C., and the District of Columbia."

"Charter Horse Bus Movements applying from points in Georgetown, D. C., and the District of Columbia to other points in Georgetown, D. C., and the District of Columbia."

The Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing on this matter is required.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for public hearing on Wednesday, October 26, 1966, at 10:00 A. M., in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia 22209.


2. That applicant publish notice of application, and time and place of hearing thereon, in a newspaper of general circulation in the metropolitan district, once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said hearing.

3. That any interested party desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate in writing to the Commission, with a copy to Horse Buses Incorporated, 1081 Wisconsin Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20007, at least ten (10) days prior to said hearing.

4. That Horse Buses Incorporated be, and it is hereby, assessed the sum of \$50.00, pursuant to Section 19(a), Article XII, Title II of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact.

5. That Horse Buses Incorporated deposit said sum in the name and to the credit of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission, in the Old Dominion Bank, Rosslyn Branch, 1900 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia, at least five (5) days prior to said hearing.
