By Application No. 401, filed December 8, 1966, W. V. & M. Coach Company, Inc., requested authority to reroute its Route 11, Shirlington - Rosslyn Line as follows:

REROUTED PORTION

Outbound - Over regular route to the intersection of Walter Reed Drive and Kenmore Street, thence; continue westerly on Walter Reed Drive, south on Oakland Street, east on 24th Road, Lowell Street and 25th Street to its intersection with Shirlington Road, thence continue over regular route.

Inbound - Over regular route to the intersection of Shirlington Road and 25th Street, thence westerly on 25th Street, Lowell Street and 24th Road, north on Oakland Street, easterly on Walter Reed Drive to its intersection with Kenmore Street, thence continue Walter Reed Drive and regular route.

DISCONTINUED PORTION

Kenmore Street - Between Walter Reed Drive and Shirlington Road.

Shirlington Road - Between Kenmore Street and 25th Street.

NOTE: Routes 8-N and 10 will continue to operate via Kenmore Street and Shirlington Road.

Pursuant to Commission Order No. 630, Route 11 has been operated in the above manner since July 11, 1966.

The Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing is required on the question of permanent authority.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Tuesday, January 10, 1967, at 10:00 A.M. in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia 22209.

2. That applicant publish notice of application, and time and place of hearing thereon, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said hearing.

3. That any substantially interested party desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate in writing to the Commission, with a copy to the Attorney of Record, at least ten (10) days prior to said hearing.
