By Application No. 420, dated January 31, 1967, Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., requested authority to change its Routes 1-R and 3-R, Pimmit Hills Service, as follows:

A. Discontinued Portion

1. Lisle Avenue - between Ware Road and Edgar Road

B. Rerouted Portion

1. Outbound - Over regular route to the intersection of Lisle Avenue and Ware Road, thence north on Ware Road, west on Magarity Road, east on Lisle Avenue, south on Edgar Court and north on service road of Leesburg Pike to Terminal Stand on the east side of service roadway south of Lisle Avenue.
2. Inbound - From Terminal, continue north on service roadway, east on Magarity Road and south on Ware Road to its intersection with Lisle Avenue, thence continue east on Lisle Avenue and regular route.

The Commission is of the opinion, and finds, that a public hearing should be scheduled on this matter.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Thursday, March 16, 1967, at 10:00 A. M., at the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia 22209.

2. That applicant publish notice of application and hearing thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said hearing.

3. That any interested person desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate in writing to the Commission, with a copy to applicant's attorney of record, Manuel J. Davis, 1629 K Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., at least ten (10) days prior to said hearing.
