On January 13, 1967, Alexandria, Barcroft, and Washington Transit Company filed certain tariffs setting forth increased fares, accompanied by an application and prepared testimony and exhibits.

The Commission is of the opinion that the tariffs should be suspended in order that the Commission may give consideration to the financial condition and revenue requirements of the Company, and to enable the Commission to determine whether it is being operated economically and efficiently and whether the proposed fares are just and reasonable.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Alexandria, Barcroft, and Washington Transit Company Supplement No. 5 to WMATC Tariff No. 2 (Joint), Supplement No. 5 to WMATC Tariff No. 5 (Joint), and WMATC Tariff No. 23 be, and they are hereby, suspended, and the use of the fares stated therein be, and they are hereby, deferred, pending investigation and hearing thereon until May 14, 1967, unless otherwise ordered.
