Application No. 421

On February 8, 1967, Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company filed Application No. 421 requesting temporary authority to change its Route No. 4 as follows:

Via regular route to South Van Dorn Street; right on south Van Dorn Street to Edsall Road; left on Edsall Road to Lincolnia Road; right on Lincolnia Road to newly aligned Lincolnia Road; right and via new Lincolnia Road to Duke Street; left on Duke Street and regular route.

The Commission is of the opinion that there is an immediate and urgent need for this change due to the construction of a new interchange at Shirley Highway and Duke Street, and the re-alignment of Lincolnia Road at its intersection with Duke Street.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company be, and it is hereby, granted one hundred eighty (180) days temporary authority to change its Route No. 4 as described herein.
2. That this order become effective Monday, February 20, 1967.
