The Commission has heretofore issued Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 3 to White-Way Sightseeing Tours, Inc. The official name of the corporation has been officially changed to Washington Sightseeing Tours, Inc., and the request has been made to amend said certificate to reflect the change in name of the corporation.

The Commission is of the opinion that the amendment should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 3 be, and it is hereby, amended by changing the words "White-Way Sightseeing Tours, Inc." to "Washington Sightseeing Tours, Inc."

CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

WASHINGTON SIGHTSEEING TOURS, INC.

At a session of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission held on the 25th day of March 1966;

AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it appearing that the above named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact, and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and therefore is entitled to receive authority from this Commission to engage in the transportation of passengers within the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit District, as a carrier; and the Commission so finding;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that the said carrier be, and it is hereby, granted this certificate of public convenience and necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation as a carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter, be attached to the exercise of the privilege herein granted to the said carrier.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the transportation service to be performed by the said carrier shall be as specified below:

IRREGULAR ROUTE:

Passengers and their baggage:

(a) CHARTER OPERATIONS:

Round-trip;

- (1) From points within the District of Columbia to points within the District of Columbia.
- (2) From points within the District of Columbia, to Arlington National Cemetery and Mount Vernon, Virginia, and return.

(b) SPECIAL OPERATIONS:

Round-trip, sightseeing or pleasure tours;


- (1) From points within the District of Columbia to points within the District of Columbia.

- (2) From points within the District of Columbia to Arlington National Cemetery and Mount Vernon, Virginia, and return.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED and is made a condition of this Certificate that the holder thereof shall render reasonable, continuous and adequate service to the public in pursuance of the authority granted herein, and that failure so to do shall constitute sufficient grounds for suspension, change or revocation of this certificate.

The operating authority granted by this Certificate is granted pursuant to Order No. 565.
