On March 1, 1967, the Commission issued Order No. 682, granting, in part, the application of Horse Buses, Inc., for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. In the order, the Commission laid down certain financial conditions with which applicant has to comply before the certificate will be issued.

D. C. Transit System, Inc., has filed an application for reconsideration of Order No. 682, specifying four (4) grounds of error. The only ground of merit appears to be its specification number two, relating to applicant's financial condition. While the Commission does not agree with the concept of dismissal urged upon it, it does believe that Transit should have the opportunity to review and comment upon the financial data to be developed and submitted to the Commission. The application for reconsideration should be granted, and the proceeding re-opened for the receipt of the financial evidence, and any further proceedings required thereby. The remaining allegations will also be considered and disposed of in the final order to follow.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of D. C. Transit System, Inc., for reconsideration of Order No. 682 be, and it is hereby, granted, and this proceeding is hereby re-opened, consistent with the above opinion.
