By Application No. 430, filed April 18, 1967, Warren D. McMichael requested a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to authorize the following transportation:

Irregular Route

Charter Operations

From points within Prince Georges County, Maryland, to points within the District of Columbia, Montgomery and Prince Georges Counties, Maryland and portions of Virginia located in the Metropolitan District and return on irregular routes, roundtrip utilizing school bus type vehicles.

Applicant also seeks to transport baggage in the same vehicle with passengers.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that a public hearing should be scheduled on this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing at 10:00 A.M., Tuesday, June 6, 1967, in the

2. That applicant publish notice of application and hearing thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said hearing.
