On June 1, 1967, the Commission issued Order No. 712, denying the application of Horse Buses, Inc., for a certificate of public convenience and necessity, for failure to comply with the provisions of Order No. 682, issued March 1, 1967.

On June 26, 1967, Horse Buses, Inc., filed a request for reconsideration of Order No. 712. While no new facts or arguments are called to our attention which would be cause for granting rehearing or disturbing our original opinion, the request raises two matters which require comment. First is the allegation that Horse Buses, Inc., had in fact secured the financial minimums established by the Commission in Order No. 682 on or before the May 31 deadline, but had merely failed to timely submit proof thereof. There is no support for this claim set forth in the request. Moreover, the allegation is in conflict with prior pleadings of the applicant filed on and after May 31, 1967, which clearly reveal that applicant had not completed its financial arrangement on or before May 31. The findings and conclusions set forth in Order No. 712 remain unchanged.


Lastly, we note that the request raises, for the first time, several other matters dealing with determinations set

forth in Order No. 682. The time in which to challenge findings in that Order has long since expired, by virtue of the provisions of Section 16 of the Compact.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request for reconsideration should be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Horse Buses, Inc., for reconsideration of Order No. 712 be, and it is hereby, denied.
