By Application No. 439, filed June 27, 1967, Horse Buses Incorporated seeks authority "to operate as a common carrier of passengers by horse-drawn vehicle" in a specific area of Washington, D. C. defined as follows:

GEORGETOWN:

Bounded on the east by Rock Creek and Potomac Parkway from the Potomac River to the north boundary of Dumbarton Oaks Park, on the north by the north boundary of Dumbarton Oaks Park, Whitehaven Street and Whitehaven Parkway to Thirty-fifth Street, south along the middle of Thirty-fifth Street to Reservoir Road, west along Reservoir Road to Archbold Parkway, on the west by the Archbold Parkway from Reservoir Road to the Potomac River, on the south by the Potomac River to the Rock Creek Parkway.

The Company requests authority to provide:

"Horse Hurdic Movements applying from points in Georgetown, D. C., to other points in Georgetown, D. C.";

"Horse Bus Sightseeing Movements applying from points in Georgetown, D. C., to other points in Georgetown, D. C.";and

"Charter Horse Bus Movements applying from points in Georgetown, D. C., to other points in Georgetown, D. C."

The Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing on the matter is required.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Monday, September 11, 1967, at 10:00 A.M., in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia 22209.

2. That applicant publish notice of application, and time and place of hearing thereon, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said hearing.

3. That any interested party desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate in writing to the Commission, with a copy to applicant's attorney of record, Paul J. McGarvey, Esquire, Woodward Building, Washington, D. C., at least ten (10) days prior to said hearing.
