WMA Transit Company, by Application No. 449 filed August 17, 1967, requests an amendment of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 8 to extend its Route P in Prince Georges County, Maryland, as follows:

Originating at the bus stand at the Hecht Company entrance on St. Clair Drive in Marlow Heights; proceeding north on St. Clair Drive, left on Keith Street, right on 28th Avenue, right on Iverson Street, continue on Silver Hill Road, left on Suitland Road to connecting bus stop, turn around in Census Grounds and continue east on Suitland Road, left on Silver Hill Road, right on Old Silver Hill Road, right on Marlboro Pike, left on County Road. At this point, proposed route will join with existing Route P and follow existing routing to Central Avenue and 78th Street. Then continue east on Central Avenue, right on Landover Road and right into special bus driveway at Prince Georges Community College and return over the same route.

The Commission finds that a public hearing is required on this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Thursday, September 14, 1967, at 10:00 A.M., in the office of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia 22209.

2. That applicant publish notice of application and hearing thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least fourteen (14) days prior to said hearing.

3. That any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall notify the Commission in writing with a copy to applicant's attorney of record, Stanley H. Kamerow, Esquire, 1025 Vermont Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20005, at least five (5) days prior to said hearing.
