
On October 9, 1961, the Commission, by Order No. 67, prescribed certain interstate taxicab rates, charges and regulations. The Commission also provided that the rates, charges and regulations prescribed in said Order were to become effective November 1, 1961.

The Commission has received numerous requests that it postpone the effective date of said Order in order that it may prescribe new and additional regulations governing the matter of interstate taxicab rates and charges. The Commission is impressed with the need for additional and supplemental regulations and is of the opinion that it should postpone the effective date of the rates and charges prescribed in said Order No. 67.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the interstate rates, charges and regulations prescribed in Order No. 67 shall become effective December 1, 1961.
2. That Paragraph 3, of Order No. 67, prescribing an effective date of November 1, 1961 be, and it is, canceled, set aside and held for naught.
