By Application No. 498 filed April 12, 1968, D. C. Transit System, Inc., requests authority to change its Route Y-8 as follows:

ROCKVILLE-VIERS MILL ROAD LINE, ROUTE Y-8

Discontinued Portion (in both directions)

1. Randolph Road between Parklawn Avenue and Rockville Pike
2. Rockville Pike between Randolph Road and Twinbrook Parkway
3. E. Jefferson Street between Rollins Avenue and Halpine Road

Rerouted Portion

1. Outbound - Over regular route to Randolph Road and Parklawn Avenue, thence northerly on Parklawn Avenue and west on Twinbrook Parkway to Rockville Pike, thence north on Rockville Pike and regular route.
2. Inbound - Over regular route to Rockville Pike and Twinbrook Parkway, thence east on Twinbrook Parkway and southerly on Parklawn Avenue to Randolph Road, thence east on Randolph Road, and regular route.

Extended Portion


1. Outbound - Over regular route to Rollins Avenue and E. Jefferson Street, thence continue east on Rollins Avenue, south on E. Jefferson Street (new), west on Montrose Road, south on Seven Locks Road, east on Democracy Boulevard and northerly on roadways of Montgomery Mall Shopping Center to the present Route 0-8 terminal stand.
2. Inbound - From present Route 0-8 terminal stand southerly on the roadways of Montgomery Mall Shopping Center, west on Democracy Boulevard, north on Seven Locks Road, east on Montrose Road, north on E. Jefferson Street (new), west on Rollins Avenue, northeast on Congressional Lane, south on E. Jefferson Street and east on Halpine Road and regular route.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that a public hearing should be scheduled on this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Monday, May 13, 1968, at 10:00 A.M., in the Hearing Room of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia 22209.
2. That applicant publish notice of application and hearing thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, on or before Wednesday, April 24, 1968.
3. That any interested person desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate in writing to the Commission, with a copy to applicant's attorney of record, Manuel J. Davis, Special Counsel, D. C. Transit System, Inc., 1420 New York Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20005, on or before Wednesday, May 8, 1968.
