On August 15, 1968, the Commission entered Order No. 854, suspending the proposed tariffs previously filed in this proceeding, and deferring the use of the rates and charges stated therein, until October 1, 1968, unless otherwise ordered. The Commission has held and concluded public hearings on the proposed increase and has the matter under active consideration; however, it has not completed its work on the opinion and order, making a final disposition of the matter.

The Commission is therefore of the opinion that, pursuant to Section 6(a)(2) of the Compact, said tariffs should be further suspended.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the tariffs described in Order No. 854 be, and they are hereby, further suspended until October 14, 1968, unless otherwise ordered.
