By application filed January 13, 1969, D. C. Transit System, Inc., requests 180 day temporary authority to extend certain trips on its Routes K-7 and K-9 to White Oak, Maryland, in the following manner:

INBOUND - From White Oak (Eldorado Towers) - Leave from the existing bus stop within the apartment complex at circular Drive to #11215 then continue around the outer roadway of the apartment complex to the Lockwood Drive exit, south on exit road, east on Lockwood Drive, southerly on New Hampshire Avenue and west on Northampton Drive and regular route.

OUTBOUND - Over regular route to New Hampshire Avenue and Southampton Drive, thence west and north on Southampton Drive, north and east on Northampton Drive, northerly on New Hampshire Avenue, westerly on Lockwood Drive, northerly on Oakleaf Drive to the first entrance to the Eldorado, thence around the outer roadway of the apartment complex to the existing bus stop at the circular drive to #11200.

LIMITED STOP RESTRICTIONS: No change from present restrictions.


The Commission is of the opinion that there is an urgent and immediate need for the proposed service and that the

application should be granted.

1. That the application of D. C. Transit System, Inc. for temporary authority to extend Routes K-7 and K-9, as herein above described, be, and it is hereby, granted, effective Monday, February 3, 1969.
