

Public hearings in this case were held during the day and evening of March 4, 1969. As part of its rebuttal, the Applicant offered Exhibits Numbered 13 through 18, containing data on daily revenues in February of 1969, peak load passenger counts and other passenger tabulations based on counts taken during the first part of February 1969. Before the material could be analyzed and response made by the Commission staff or intervenor, the public hearing was recessed, subject to reopening on another day.

On March 5, 1969, counsel for Applicant advised the Commission in writing that the Applicant was withdrawing Exhibits Numbered 13 through 18 and would not desire to offer those Exhibits in evidence. There is thus no need for further hearings in this proceeding.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the record, in the case of Application No. 550, Docket No. 197, be, and it is hereby, closed.
