D. C. Transit System, Inc., filed Application No. 444, seeking authority to change the base schedule on its Cabin John Shuttle Line, Routes 20 and 21, to abandon Saturday and Sunday service and to establish a new weekday schedule.

The Commission held a public hearing on this subject, closed the record, and took the matter under consideration. We have diligently explored this problem; nevertheless, we find ourselves unable to determine an adequate disposition of it on the basis of the present record. Consequently, by this Order, we are today reopening this proceeding for further hearings.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the record in Docket No. 150 be, and it is hereby, reopened for the purpose of taking further evidence.
2. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Tuesday, April 22, 1969, at 10:00 a.m. in the Hearing Room of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia 22209.
3. That applicant publish notice of application and hearing thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said hearing.

4. That applicant post notice of application and hearing thereon in all of its buses operating over the routes concerned in the said application for at least twenty-five (25) days prior to said hearing.

5. That any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall notify the Commission in writing with a copy to applicant's attorney of record, Manuel J. Davis, Special Counsel, D. C. Transit System, Inc., 1420 New York Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20005, at least ten (10) days prior to said hearing.
