By Application No. 560, filed March 14, 1969, the Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., (W.V.&M.) requests authority to extend its Routes 1, 3, 5, and 7, and follows:

WILSON BOULEVARD LINE, Route 1, and LEE HIGHWAY LINE, Route 3:

Over regular route to Leesburg Pike (Va. 7) and International Boulevard, thence northerly on International Boulevard and other roadways of the Tysons Corner Shopping Center necessary to reach the terminal stand on the parking lot roadway adjacent to the west entrance to the Hecht Company store. Returning southerly on Tysons Corner Shopping Center Roadways and International Boulevard to Leesburg Pike (Va. 7) and regular route.

CHAIN BRIDGE ROAD LINE, Routes 5 and 7:

Over regular route to Dolley Madison Boulevard (Va. 123) and International Boulevard, thence southerly on International Boulevard and other Tysons Corner Shopping Center roadways passing in front of the west entrance to the Hecht Company store, returning northerly on International Boulevard to Dolley Madison Boulevard (Va. 123) and regular route. It will be noted that selected trips in each direction will operate over this route in order to serve the shopping center.

The Commission finds that a public hearing on this matter is required.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Friday, April 25, 1969, at 10:00 a.m. in the Hearing Room of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia, 22209.

2. That applicant publish notice of application and hearing thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least fifteen (15) days prior to said hearing.

3. That any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall notify the Commission in writing with a copy to the applicant's attorney of record, Manuel J. Davis, Esq., 1420 New York Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C., 20005, at least ten (10) days prior to said hearing.
