
On January 23, 1969, we served Order No. 911, by which we dismissed an application of Joel Yohalem for reconsideration of Order No. 900, stating that the applicant's request had not been filed within the statutory period prescribed in Article XII, Section 16 of the Compact. Subsequently, Mr. Yohalem filed a motion requesting us to waive our rules and regulations and accept the application. We denied this request, serving Order No. 930 on February 20, 1969.

By application filed March 20, 1969, Mr. Yohalem now requests reconsideration of Order No. 930, stating in support thereof as follows:  
(1) That his application for reconsideration of Order No. 900 raises important issues which deserve consideration on their merits, and,  
(2) That no harm or undesirable effects will flow from a waiver of the Commission's rules and regulations.

In Order No. 930, we considered all the issues and spelled out in detail our disposition of those issues and set forth the reasons behind our decision. The instant application raises no issues not previously considered. Consequently, we will deny the instant application for reconsideration.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Joel Yohalem for reconsideration of Order No. 930 be, and it is hereby, denied.
