

On February 18, 1969, the Commission entered Order No. 927, suspending the proposed tariffs previously filed in this proceeding, and deferring the use of the rates and charges stated therein, until May 12, 1969, unless otherwise ordered. The Commission has held and concluded public hearings on the proposed increase and has the matter under active consideration; however, it has not completed its work on the opinion and order making a final disposition of the matter.

The Commission is of the opinion that, pursuant to Section 6(a)(2) of the Compact, said tariffs should be further suspended.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the tariffs described in Order No. 927 be, and they are hereby, further suspended until June 12, 1969, unless otherwise ordered.
