In Order No. 939, issued April 11, 1969, the Commission authorized the institution of a new interline ticket fare collection system by the WMA Transit Company. However, in response to a petition by the company, the Commission in Order No. 940 temporarily suspended the new interline ticket fare collection system because it conflicted with tariffs of connecting carriers.

By Order No. 946, issued May 20, 1969, the Commission, among other things, authorized A. B. & W. Transit Company to institute the same system we had authorized in Order No. 939, thereby removing the impediment that caused the Commission to suspend institution of the interline ticket fare collection system by WMA Transit Company. The purpose of this order is to remove the suspension of Order No. 940.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of Order No. 939 be, and it is hereby, reinstated, with amendments as to effective date, to read as follows:

3. That WMA Transit Company shall file appropriate tariffs on or before May 23, 1969, to become effective, at or after 12:01 A.M., May 24, 1969, instituting an interline ticket fare collection system whereby the originating company shall collect its appropriate zone fare and issue an interline ticket, for no extra charge, which will permit a five cent discount on the connecting carrier's regular service.

2. That Appendix A to Order No. 939, as amended by Order No. 940, is hereby amended to reinstate the language originally included therein as follows:

\*Interline ticket issued upon request, after payment of proper fare, worth 5¢ toward fare on connecting carrier. Interline ticket accepted from connecting carrier worth 5¢ toward WMA fare.
