Archie L. Milling filed a formal complaint against D. C. Transit System, Inc., alleging that D. C. Transit System, Inc., has been, and is, engaging in illegal sightseeing operations within the Metropolitan District originating in Virginia. Also, the complaint seeks the Commission to issue an order requiring D. C. Transit System, Inc., to cease and desist from said operations and grant such other relief as shall be just and reasonable within the purpose and intent of the Compact.

D. C. Transit System, Inc., filed an answer, in the nature of a motion to dismiss the complaint, alleging the complaint fails to state a cause of action upon which the relief sought may be granted.

The parties having failed to settle the dispute informally, the Commission is of the opinion that this matter should be set for hearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the formal complaint filed by Archie L. Milling against D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on December 7, 1961, at 10:00 a. m., E. S. T., in the office of the Executive Director of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission, 1801 North Moore Street, Arlington 9, Virginia.

2. That D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is hereby, made respondent to this proceeding.
