By Application No. 577, filed June 16, 1969, the Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company requests temporary authority to change Route 18 outbound trips, during the P.M. rush hours only, as follows:

ROUTE 18, SPRINGFIELD-PENTAGON-WASHINGTON LINE

DISCONTINUED PORTION:

Outbound - From junction of Backlick Road and Amherst Avenue, over Backlick Road, right on Floyd Avenue to junction with Amherst Avenue.

REROUTED PORTION:

Outbound - From Backlick Road right on Amherst Avenue, right on Floyd Avenue, thence over regular route.

The Commission is of the opinion that there is an immediate and urgent need for the proposed routing of this service and that temporary authority should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company be, and it is hereby, granted one hundred eighty (180) day temporary authority to change its Route 18 as described herein.

2. That this order become effective immediately.
