

By Order No. 960, dated July 2, 1969, the Commission instituted an investigation of the practices of D. C. Transit System, Inc., in conducting charter operations during rush hours, to determine the impact of those operations on its regular route operations. Since the issuance of Order No. 960, certain other area regular route bus companies have failed to operate some scheduled rush-hour runs, while apparently operating charter trips at those times. Therefore, we have decided to expand the initial investigation to include all other area regular route bus companies.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the investigation instituted in Order No. 960 include an examination of the practices of the W. V. & M. Coach Company, A. B. & W. Transit Company and WMA Transit Company in providing charter and sightseeing services, and the relationship of those practices to the adequacy of service in their regular route operations.
