Application No. 584

WMA Transit Company filed Application No. 584 with the Commission on August 28, 1969, seeking temporary authority to extend Route P in the following manner:

Route P-4

Northbound - Leave layover point on Gateway Boulevard at Marlboro Pike, north on County Road, Walker Mill Road, and Addison Road, east on Central Avenue, north on 78th Street, west on Canyon Street, north on 75th Street, east on Franklin Drive, north on 78th Street, west on D Street, north on 76th Street, west on F Street and Addison Road, south on Roosevelt Avenue and 63rd Street, N. E., northeast on Southern Avenue, and northwest on Eastern Avenue to layover point at Eastern Avenue and 63rd Street.

Southbound - Leave layover point on Eastern Avenue at 63rd Street, N. E., north on Roosevelt Avenue, east on Addison Road and F Street, south on 76th Street, east on D Street, south on 78th Street, west on Central Avenue, south on Addison Road, Walker Mill Road, and County Road, east on Foster Street, south on 72nd Avenue, and west on Gateway Boulevard to layover point at Gateway Boulevard and Marlboro Pike.

In support of the application, WMA filed a petition with 144 signatures from residents in the vicinity of F Street, Seat Pleasant, Maryland, requesting bus service.


The Commission finds that there is an immediate and urgent need for the service as indicated by the petition submitted and we will authorize temporary operation for a period of 180 days.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of WMA Transit Company for temporary authority to extend Route P be, and it is hereby, granted for a period of 180 days.

2. That this temporary authority will commence as of September 29, 1969.
