In Order No. 984, issued October 24, 1969, the Commission authorized the use of tokens in the Maryland service offered by D. C. Transit System, Inc. The tariff for the Silver Rocket Express, a joint service between Maryland and the District of Columbia and Virginia provided by D. C. Transit and the W. V. & M. Coach Company, was not in issue in the proceeding that led to Order No. 984. However, the companies have filed Joint Tariff No. 7, revised title page and pages 6, 7, 8, and 10, to amend that tariff to reflect a new rule which authorizes the use of tokens at any point on the Silver Rocket Express, and further to amend the statement in the tariff with respect to the value that a D. C. Transit transfer will have on the Silver Rocket Express.

Transit has also filed Tariff No. 44, revised title page and page 6, to effect similar changes on the Glenmont Rocket Express. The tariffs now provide that the transfer will be accepted at a value of 30¢, but since the D. C. fare and the intra-Maryland fare have been raised to 32¢, the transfer will be accepted at a value of 32¢ toward either the Silver Rocket or the Glenmont Rocket fare.


These changes described above are purely in the nature of accommodation to the rider and we see no need to defer their effectiveness.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Fourth Revised Title Page; Second Revised Page 6, Third Revised Page 7, Third Revised Page 8 and Second Revised Page 10 to Joint WMATC Tariff No. 7 of D. C. Transit System, Inc., and Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company be, and they are hereby, approved, effective October 29, 1969.

2. That First Revised Title Page and First Revised Page 6 to WMATC Tariff No. 44 be, and they are hereby, approved, effective October 29, 1969.
