By application accepted for filing August 29, 2005, Nacole Alandrea Brown, a sole proprietor trading as BWI Airport Xpress Shuttle Services, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains group charter rates, but does not specify when those rates will apply, or whether those rates will be computed on an hourly or some other basis. Applicant will be directed to file with the Commission an amended Exhibit B, containing a description of proposed service, proposed rates for transportation covered by this proceeding, and describing when those rates will apply and how they will be computed.

Applicant's Exhibit C contains a photo identification card, but does not include a copy of a valid driver's license, which is required for sole proprietor applicants. Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit C.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 4, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 18, 2005, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 18, 2005, an amended Exhibit B, containing a description

of proposed service, proposed rates for transportation covered by this proceeding, and describing when those rates will apply and how they will be computed.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 18, 2005, an amended Exhibit C, which includes a photocopy of a valid driver's license.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is October 18, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant at 27 Keepsake Place, Waldorf, MD 20602.
