Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 503 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$1 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on September 15, 2005, without replacement, and Certificate No. 503 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 8994, served September 16, 2005.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and an acceptable \$1 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on October 3, 2005. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
