Case No. AP-2005-104

Applicant proposes commencing operations with three vans and one minibus. Applicant's proposed tariff contains one-way and round-trip rates for ambulatory and wheelchair transportation.

Notice of this application was served on August 3, 2005, in Order No. 8873, and applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 17, 2005. Applicant was also directed to file an affidavit that notice was published in a newspaper, designate a registered agent inside the Metropolitan District, and file an amended Exhibit B no later than August 31, 2005.

On September 29, 2005, applicant filed a request for an extension of the publication and document submission deadline.

The deadline for publication, designation of a registered agent, and filing an amended Exhibit B shall be extended as requested. A new protest deadline, which is determined by reference to the publication deadline, shall be established, as well.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 1, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 15, 2005, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 15, 2005, an original and four copies of a statement designating an agent inside the Metropolitan District to accept service on behalf of applicant.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 15, 2005, an original and four copies of an amended Exhibit B containing specific rates for each category of its services.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 15, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Evelyne Sama, 12047 Paper Birch Lane, Gainesville, VA 20155.
