By application accepted for filing October 25, 2005, Jaymag Trans Services LLC, a Maryland limited liability company, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one sedan, but applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for van transportation under the District of Columbia Medicaid program. Applicant will be directed to file a statement explaining this discrepancy.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 22, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 6, 2005, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 6, 2005, a statement explaining the internal inconsistency of applicant's proposal to operate a sedan service at rates published for vans.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is December 6, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Margaret Ekumoh Oguntayo, 12007 Fairway Manor Court, Upper Marlboro, MD 20772.
