By application accepted for filing November 29, 2005, Pronto Sedan and Limousine Transportation, LLC, a Maryland entity, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one sedan. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly charter rate and rates for transportation between Bethesda, MD, on the one hand, and Union Station, Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport, and Washington-Dulles International Airport, on the other.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than December 28, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than January 11, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is January 11, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Francis Quao Cleland, 11640 Stewart Lane, #104, Silver Spring, MD 20904.
