Irregular Route Operations )

By application accepted for filing December 6, 2005, Felicia E. Medlock, a sole proprietor, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

This is the second application filed by applicant. Applicant applied last year for a certificate of authority, but the application was denied without prejudice for failure to establish operational fitness.<sup>1</sup> In the first application: (1) applicant proposed a tariff containing rates for van service only under a contract with Wayson's Bingo; (2) no other service was proposed; and (3) applicant's proposed vehicle list did not include any vans.<sup>2</sup>

The instant application does not contain the Wayson's Bingo contract or any other proposed rates. Applicant will be directed to file with the Commission an Exhibit B containing the van and sedan rates that applicant proposes.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than January 27, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 10, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 10, 2006, an Exhibit B containing the van and sedan rates that applicant proposes.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is February 10, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant at 14 Jefferson Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20011.
