By application accepted for filing December 27, 2005, United Transportation, Inc., a Maryland entity trading as UTI Motor Coach, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with eight sedans, one limousine, one minibus, one van, and one SUV. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly group charter rates, with minimum charges, and fares for transportation between northwest Washington, DC, on the one hand, and Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport, Washington-Dulles International Airport, Union Station, and the New Carrollton AMTRAK station, on the other.

Applicant claims to have federal passenger carrier authority, but Exhibit F to the application, applicant's alleged proof of authority, was issued in the name of UTI Motor Coach Inc. Applicant will be directed to explain this discrepancy and furnish proof of trade name registration with the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than January 27, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 10, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 10, 2006, a written statement explaining why applicant's proof of federal passenger carrier authority displays the name UTI Motor Coach Inc.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 10, 2006, proof of trade name registration with the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is February 10, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant's CEO, Azhar J. Roy, 1010 Rockville Pike, #208, Rockville, MD 20852.
